Additional Information and Qualifications:

- Required: Bachelor's degree
- Preferred candidates are currently pursuing a Master's degree in psychology, education, counseling, sport management, or a related field.
- Ability to multitask, problem solve, effectively communicate both verbally and written, and interact with multiple people simultaneously.
- This position requires the ability to consistently accomplish tasks, communicate with multiple stakeholders, have a desire to work in higher education, an educational support role or student-athletes academic support, with minimal supervision, excellent listening, written and verbal skills.

Notes:

This is an hourly position, capped at 14 hours per week with a rate of \$15 per hour. The commitment is for one semester, with a renewal opportunity for subsequent semesters pursuant to performance. This position is intended to give Master's level students hands-on experience working in academic support and mentorship at the college level. We have the ability to provide the necessary supervision to apply this experience toward practicum hours.
